#### Important Information on Pricing & Participation for Eurosatory 2026:

- Eurosatory admission badges are controlled and require online registration and identity verification. In the past, badge pricing and eligibility has varied by visitor profile and typically has been 110 EUR/person for 5 day-show pass. Each attendee is responsible for ordering their own badge directly with Eurosatory once badge registration ordering is published online.
- Walker packages do not include being listed as a co exhibitor on the show floor directory. If you are interested in co-exhibitor visibility in the show directory, please contact STEP for options and pricing.



# Mission Pricing

- STEP and CADSI are not responsible for your badge registration or access to enter the show. This is the responsibility of each mission registrant and is to be completed with the show organizer (Eurosatory) directly.
- To enable access to the Western Canada booth space and the Western Canada programming, participants must register for the CADSI Walker Program through this mission registration – not through CADSI's website/portal.
- After receipt of your completed mission registration form and after STEP's receipt of your payment, STEP will register approved Saskatchewan participants into the CADSI Walker Program.
- \*All items marked with asterisks in pricing table are features/benefits of the CADSI Walker program and are available based on availability from CADSI. CADSI-hosted events are typically on a first-come-first-serve basis with registration. It is important you register early on as STEP cannot guarantee your attendance at these events if registering late.
